25th Annual Day Report by the Principal.

- The Training & Placement cell provided a full-fledged training and assessment in the areas like Soft skill, Verbal, Aptitude, Technical skills and Value Added Training on emerging fields to the students.
- Students attended both on-campus and off-campus drives for recruitment process. In total 281 students from various departments got placed.
- Students are encouraged to participate in seminars and symposiums. Value added courses were also organized.
- 12 Add on/ Certificate programmes were offered.
- 379 students enrolled in subject related Certificate or Add on Programmes.
- A total number of 266 students were admitted for all disciplines.
- In the final year examination, 186 students appeared, and 149 of them passed. The percentage of graduation during the year 2022-'23 was 80.11.
- More than 41 faculty members attended Workshops/ Seminars/ STTPs / Induction Programme/ Refresher Course in other Technical Institutions to uplift skill sets on innovative technologies.
- 13 Professional Development/ Administrative Training Programmes were organized by the institution for teaching and non-teaching staff.
- Journals are published in international and national journals by our faculty members on regular basis. Totally 23 research papers were published in the reputed journals by our faculty members during this academic year.
- The Faculty members from the various departments published 13 books during this academic year.
- 264 students were admitted from the reserved category.
- Our Institution has 24 full time teachers with Ph.D.
- 41 Workshops/ seminars were conducted on Research Methodology, Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and entrepreneurship.
